Lolita Irene Livermon, affectionately known as "Sweet Lita", departed this life on Friday, March 15, 2019 in Thomas Hospital in Charleston, West Virginia, surrounded in love and in the presence of her friend, Carol, and her sisters, Sheryl and Kim. Lita was born in Portsmouth, Virginia on January 3, 1963, to Matthew Lee Livermon, Jr., and Zertha Cornell Richardson Livermon. She attended St. Paul's Catholic School, Portsmouth and Chesapeake Public Schools, and was a 1981 graduate of Deep Creek High School. In 1980, Lita joined the Army National Guard and served her country proudly for 8 years.

After her tour of service, Lita worked at several local stores and at Norfolk Naval Shipyard. She later moved to Atlanta, and in 2002 she settled in the place where she found peace, quiet, and rest in Leon, West Virginia. Lita worked hard her entire life, until she was set back by knee and hip problems requiring several surgeries, and finally by the illness that took her away from us too soon.
