Lottie attended the Portsmouth City School System, graduated from I.C. Norcom High School in February 1956 and continued her education at West Virginia State University. Later Lottie travelled to New York to assume a bookkeeper position at the Brooklyn US Athletic Association in Brooklyn, N.Y.. After her tenure in New York, she returned to Portsmouth and worked for the Portsmouth School System as a Librarian & Reading Specialist for over 30 years. Up until her death, she was an active board member of the International Black Women's Congress, Norfolk Chapter.

Lottie was a member of St. James Episcopal Church in Portsmouth, VA. where she faithfully served for over fifty years. She leaves to cherish her memory to her children; Tonya and Vincent Woodis; three brothers: John Chancey Ellis (Linda), Maurice A. Ellis (Phyllis), Michael J. Ellis (Karen) and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, friends and a loving uncle, Robert Brown of Philadelphia, PA.

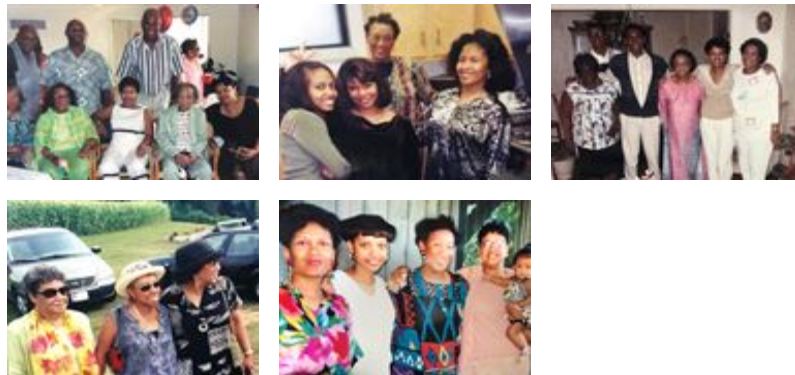
