Louis E. Slaughter was born on May 14, 1932 in Ahoskie, N.C. to the late Sampson and Virtley Slaughter. He departed this life on October 19, 2021. He attended public schools in Norfolk, graduated from Booker T. Washington High School in 1950. He served in the U.S Army as a Field Radio Repairman, training in Camp Gordon, GA, then served a year of overseas service in Korea. After leaving the Army, he attended Norfolk State College and graduated with a bachelor degree in electronics. He started working for the U.S. Postal Service in 1956 for 30+ years, first as a letter carrier, then as a postal clerk in the main post office in Norfolk, VA. He worked many side jobs in support of his family, from longshoreman, shining cars to factory line work at King Koil Mattress Co. Louis moved his family to Portsmouth, VA in 1963. He was a member of New Bethel Baptist Church under the leadership of Bishop James M. Whitaker for over 50 years. He was preceded in death by his wife of 41 years, Mattie C. (Alston) Slaughter and his older brother Eugene Slaughter and a great grandson Amadeus Credle.

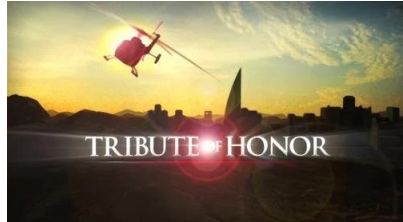

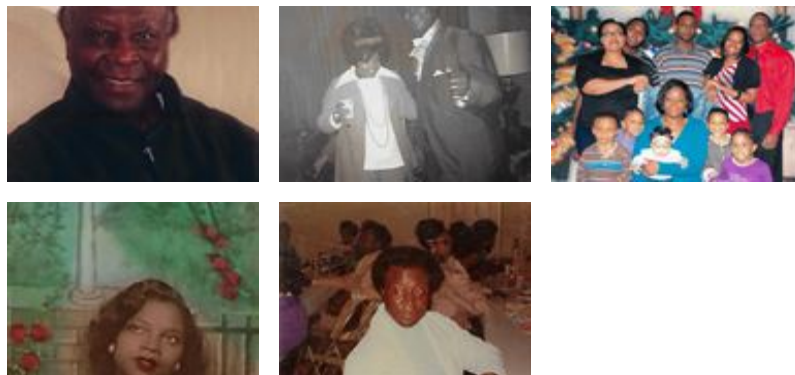
