“ I’m shocked to learn of my friend’s passing. I lost contact with him about 5 years ago. I met “Stockton” on July 15, 1998. It was our first day of Basic Training. He was wearing a purple Yankee jersey that made him an easy target for the drill instructors. He was defiant and unbothered. Wasn’t moved by them at all. Then he became our Deputy Dorm Chief - a position they created just for him to keep everybody in line. The day of basic graduation, the drill instructors were screaming at him cause he said he didn’t know who put a mattress in the drill instructors office. One of them threw a chair in the chow hall. He didn’t flinch - and he knew it was me. He sat next to me on the bus to tech school (both in Supply - tech school was also at Lackland) and laughed and told me I owed him. We studied together in Tech School where he became a yellow rope. When I got orders in my mailbox, I saw his so I took em to his dorm and woke him up. We were both headed to England. His uniform was always pristine and boots shined. His hat always cocked slightly to the side. We went all over England. Me, him, Blade & a few others went on a road trip to Wales and frequented Great Yarmouth. He was with me in Norwich on New Years to start 1999. So many great memories of Stockton.
