



Mary Lee Stovall

March 25, 1934 - March 15, 2014

Missionary Mary Lee Stovall slipped peacefully away and was granted heavenly passage into the presence of God at 6:51 a.m. Saturday, March 15, 2014. Her final days were spent at home, surrounded by family and friends that Mary had touched in some small way throughout her very memorable life. Those who were touched by her understood that the quality of existence far exceeds the quantity.

Mary was born to the late William Henry Lewis and Lucy Green (Logan) Lewis in Pittsylvania County, Virginia on March 25, 1934. She was educated in the Pittsylvania and Halifax County School Systems. In 1950 she was wed to Vaughan Walter Brayboy and to this union they were blessed with three children; Vaughan, Jr., Larry and Gloria. After all the children were in school, she began her career in nursing by becoming a certified nursing assistant. She worked 8 years at the South Boston General Hospital in South Boston, VA., where she assisted the doctors in the emergency and delivery room. She worked in the nursery where she cared for the newborns.

On May 21, 1971 Mary and Earnest Stovall was joined in marriage, where she became a loving mother to Earnest, Jr. and David Stovall and they affectionately called "Little Ma." Upon relocating to Chesapeake, VA, she was employed by The Lafayette Villa Nursing Home in Norfolk, VA., where she worked for 8 years 6 months. Mary was also treasurer for Chesapeake

Trucking Company, Inc. which was founded by her husband, Earnest.

She began her Christian experience as a child at the Level Run Baptist Church in Pittsylvania County VA. Mary continued her work in the kingdom at The Greater Mayfield Apostolic Church in South Boston, VA. After relocating to Chesapeake, VA, she joined West Munden Baptist Church. Called to assist her son, Rev. Dr. Larry V. Brayboy, Sr., she joined Manna Missionary Baptist Church in Chesapeake, VA. in 1989.
