April 6, 1933 - April 19, 2017

McKinley "K.D." Flythe was called home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, April 19, 2017. He was born April 6, 1933, in Newsoms, VA and was educated in Southampton County Schools, graduating from Southampton Training School, Courtland, VA in 1952. He graduated from the Norfolk Division of Virginia State College in 1961. McKinley was new member of St. Mark Missionary Baptist Church, and a member of Masonic Lodge #118, Newsoms, VA.

He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War from May 1953 to April 1955. Immediately following his honorable discharge from the Army, he began a 36-year career at the Norfolk Naval Shipyard on May 4, 1953 and retired on April 30, 1989.

He is survived by his son, Kenneth Flythe, Sr. (Gina); a daughter, Sherri F. Hunter (David); two grandsons, Ja'Ron Flythe and Kenneth Flythe, Jr., three granddaughters, Davida H.
