Arlene Askew Elliott at the age 78, God dispatched his heavenly angels to Maryview Medical Center ICU in Portsmouth, VA on Wednesday August 28, 2024. A native of Portsmouth, VA she was born to the late Robert Lee Askew Sr. and Lena Faison Askew on December 1, 1945 in Ahoskie, NC.

She joined New Baptist Church of Taylorville under the leadership of Rev. T. M. Steele in her early life. She worked at Piece Goods Fabric Store where she meant a host of friends. She was a very creative and talented seamstress. Arlene loved to sing and was the president of the Angelic Voices. Later she went to Minister school at Bishop Russell Church of God In Christ in Norfolk, VA where she received her license to minister the word of God.

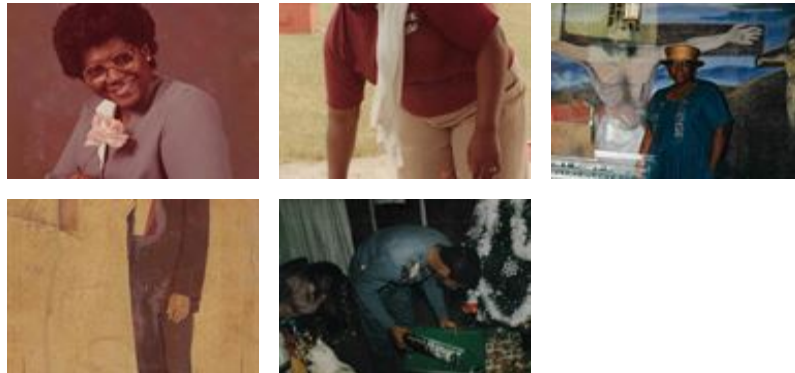
