



## Minister Easter W. Edwards

April 1, 1945 - February 10, 2026

Minister Easter Mae Warren Edwards, 80, entered eternal rest on February 10, 2026, in Kentucky. She was born April 1, 1945, in Nansemond County, Virginia, to the late Georgia Lee Holloway and James T. Brown.

She was educated in Isle of Wight County schools and attended Norfolk State College, Paul D. Camp Community College, and Tidewater Community College. She later earned a Certificate in Theology from Virginia University of Lynchburg School of Religion–Virginia Seminary. She was licensed to preach on April 23, 1995.

Minister Edwards served faithfully as an Associate Minister and Past President of the Mary L. Miller Missionary Ministry at New Hope Baptist Church. She retired from Naval Supply Systems Command after more than 30 years of service and also worked as a Librarian and Secretary at Georgia Tyler School.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Wilbur Lee Edwards; her son, Thomas Linnell Edwards; and her parents.

She leaves to cherish her memory her son, Rodney Lee Edwards; daughters-in-law Kristen Edwards and Terry Diggs; grandchildren Byron Linnell, Rashawn, Raciona, and Christian; great grandchildren Alani, Celine, Amir; siblings Marie, Barbara, Ethel, Edith, George Jr, late Joyce Ann, Thomas, and a host of extended family and friends.
