Myra Anastacia Plaskett-Cotton, transitioned into eternal rest on January 20, 2023. Myra was born December 9, 1949 to the late John Alexander Plaskett and Audrey Dolores Sheen-Plaskett in Christiansted, St. Croix U.S. Virgin Islands.

Myra was predeceased by her husband Melvin Cotton Sr., father John Alexander Plaskett, brother John Anthony Plaskett and sister Maria Indiana Plaskett who passed away shortly after birth on July 9, 1956.

Myra graduated from Portsmouth Catholic High in 1967. She attended Old Dominion University pursuing a degree in Book Keeping/Accounting. She also enjoyed her time spent with the Oakmont North Seniors. For many years Myra was a member of The Basilica of Saint Mary of Immaculate Conception. When her son was called to serve as the Senior Pastor of the New Genesis Baptist Church Virginia Beach, she created a new partnership there. During COVID-19 protocol she stayed connected virtually on Facebook Live earning the status of a Facebook Anniversary Member until her last service on January 15, 2023.

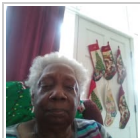
