I knew his sister, Sharon, neices, Pam an Cookie, They all treated me like family. I've eaten at their dinner table. As his eulogy stated, he was one of the few who owned a car as a teenager. I rode in that car many times: to visit friends; to ride to school; to pick up his mom from work late at night (she was a Nurse). As teenagers, we went to summer band camp to learn how to play the drums at S. H. Clark Junior High School (round about the 6th grade). We played in the band at W.E. Waters Jr. High School, I remember one summer I went over his house to see him and Mrs Johnson came to the door and said. " he's not here, Larry, he's in Florida, studying under Buddy Rich (Google Buddy Rich). When he came back I could hear that new drum set his parents bought him for blocks. Bo had found his interest. As I returned from military service, Bo and I joined forces again. We drove down to Elizabeth City, where he attended college to visit some of his and my friends. I eventually enrolled in Virginia State College. From that time on we kept in contact with each other. I knew Bo. He was a kind, thoughtful, and considerate person. He loved music and created a catalogue of songs from his heart. Bo knew God. We had many spiritual discussions on this subject. I could go on and on but let me say this. He will truly be missed by me and a host of friends. Myron lived a life of love and giving until he could give no more. He wanted the best for everybody. He loved his family dearly. They were always part of his conversation when

we talked. I knew Erica and her mother when and before Erica was born. I Later I met Mushron several times at his Barber Shop. Talented, they both are, as their father.

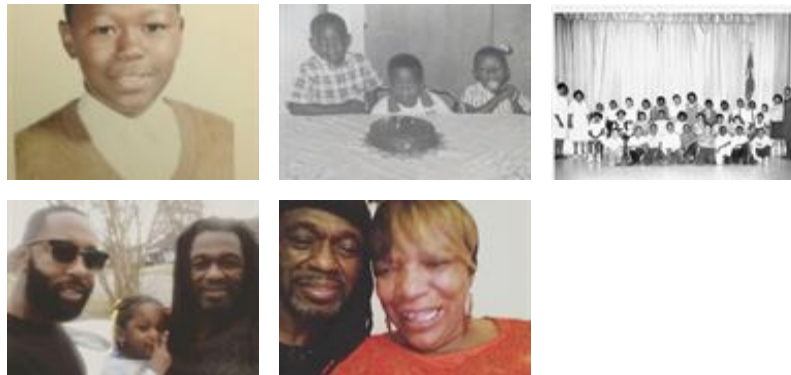
