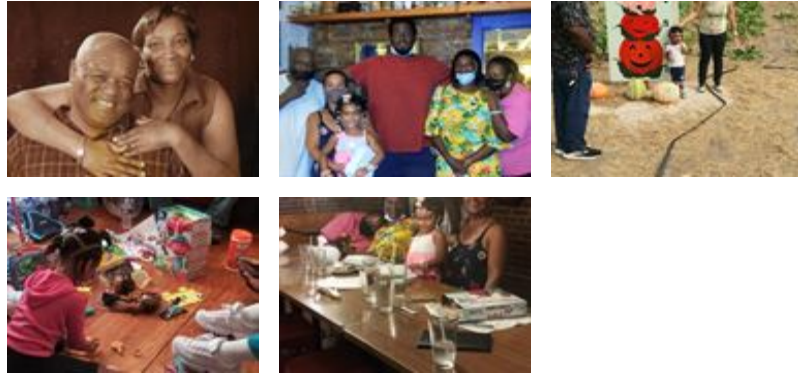

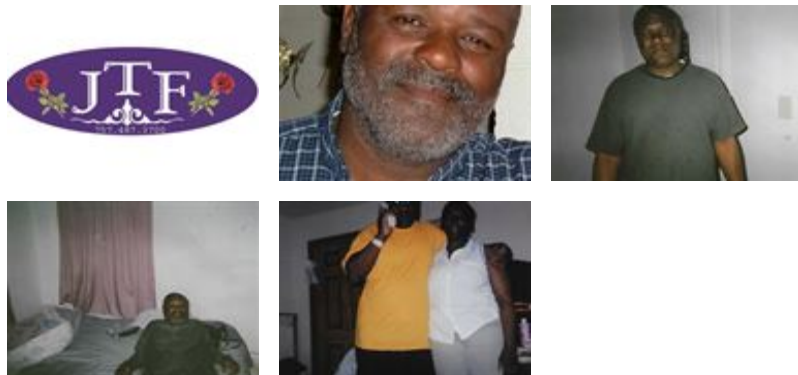

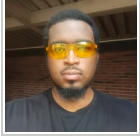

I remember Butch, we use to stay on the same street which was Wirt Ave . I use to be at his parents house all the time. We had some good times. He will be miss.

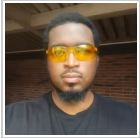
