Family members who are predeceased include: Danella M. Lemon, Daniel Lemon, Jr., Dietta Lemon Murray, and Don D. Lemon.

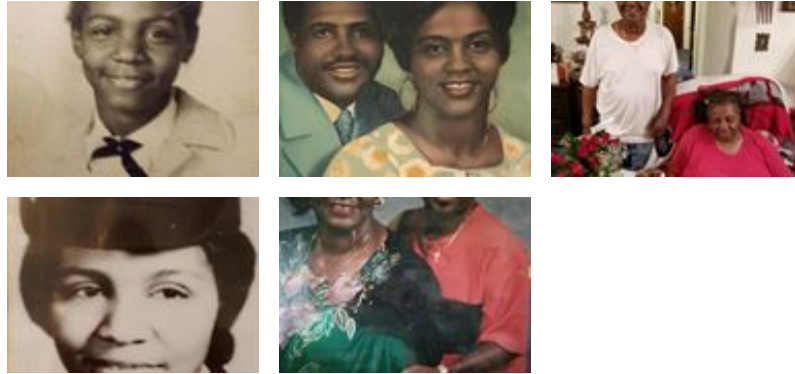
