Phyllis accepted the LORD JESUS CHRIST while attending Jerusalem United Holy Church in Chesapeake. She served on the Female Usher Board and was a member of Choir #1. Later, she joined New Light Church where she served on the Finance Committee and was a member of the Usher/Greeter Ministry.

Phyllis enjoyed working with young children. In the early years, she was a teacher at Jerusalem UHC Day Care, La Petite Academy, and Portsmouth Parks and Recreation. Also, she was the director for the Christian Antioch Church Summer Program.
