Raleigh G. Harsley Sr. passed peacefully from this life the morning of September 3rd after a gradual decline in health. He was surrounded and supported by his loving family, friends, and caregivers during the last days of his life. Raleigh was born in Lynchburg, Virginia but has lived in Portsmouth, Virginia all of his adult life.

In 1969, Raleigh retired after more than 20 years of service in the United States Navy and retired after 19 years in the Norfolk Naval Shipyard in 1990. He served several years as President of both the Lee Ward Civic League, and the Central Civic Forum. Raleigh was heavily involved with Portsmouth City Council and the Portsmouth Public School Board.

He was a member of Portsmouth American Legion Post 109. His hobbies included masonry, architectural landscaping, and making furniture.

Raleigh is survived by his wife Sadie of 68 years, 9 children Raleigh Jr., Gregory, Tyrone, Joyce, Monica, Lester, Fenton, Kent, and Rhonda. He was preceded in death by his son Conrad. Raleigh has over 20 grandchildren, over 30 great grandchildren, 1 great-great grandchild.
