Rebbie T. Warren was born September 15, 1934 to the late Roy and Freddie Anna Turner of Courtland Virginia. She departed this life and entered eternal joy on Thursday December 3, 2020 with her family gathered around her in her daughter's home in Chesapeake, VA.
