



## Rev. Dr. Medis Warren Cheek

July 6, 1939 - August 20, 2021

The Reverend Dr. Medis Warren Cheek was born in Norfolk, Virginia on July 6, 1939 to Reverends Herbert R. Warren, Sr. and Medis G. Warren. She was the eldest of two children and was preceded in death by her husband, Mr. Boyd Cheek, her parents and brother, Rev. Herbert R. Warren, Jr.

Dr. Cheek was educated in the Portsmouth Virginia Public School System having graduated from I.C. Norcom High School. She matriculated at Virginia State College graduating with a Bachelor's degree in Sociology. She earned a Masters of Social Work degree from Norfolk State University and she also earned a Masters of Divinity degree from The Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology. She received an honorary Doctorate of Ministry degree from Livingstone College.

Dr. Cheek worked as a Social Worker in New York City and Portsmouth, Virginia for a number of years. She was also a collegiate professor of Social Work at Hampton University and Virginia Commonwealth University for a number of years.

Dr. Cheek was called by God and accepted the calling into the preaching ministry. Upon her ordinations as a Deacon and Elder in the AME Zion Church she was given her first and only pastoral appointment to the Gilmerton Star AME Zion Church on the Norfolk District in the Virginia Conference.

She was a Life Matron of the Life Members Council of the WHOM Society of the AME Zion Church, Life Member of the Ministerial and Lay Association of the AME Zion Church, Association of Christian Educators of the AME Zion Church. She was a member of the Presiding Elders Council of the AME Zion Church, Church Women United, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated and The Links Incorporated.

Dr. Cheek entered into eternal rest on August 20, 2021 at the home of her son and daughter in love Jarrod and Lakisha Cheek. Those left to celebrate her life in love and the cherishing of her memories are her loving sons, Rev. Dr. Heath L. Cheek (Rev. Sharon S. Cheek, daughter in love) of Woodbridge, VA and Mr. Jarrod W. Cheek (Mrs. Lakisha Cheek, daughter in love), of Stone Mountain, GA.
