May 22, 1957 - August 3, 2023

Ronald Lynn Taylor, 66, of Chesapeake, VA, entered eternal rest on August 3, 2023. He was born on May 22, 1957, in Suffolk, Virginia, to Alease Jones and the late Roosevelt Taylor, and was preceded in death by his bonus father, Norman Jones.

Ron, as he was affectionately known, attended Western Branch High School, and later pursued higher education at Norfolk State University. He retired as a Labor Relations Officer after thirty-six years at Norfolk Southern Corporation.

Ron exemplified Christian values, strong faith, and an unwavering belief in the Bible. He was a dedicated member of Gethsemane Community Fellowship Baptist Church, a place where he found solace and community as the Senior Leader for Christian Education. Ron loved to teach, and that love was demonstrated in weekly Bible Study, Deeper Level Discipleship classes, and as an instructor in the Foundations of Faith Institute. His passion and desire for teaching God's word was contagious and inspired many to delve into the bible to enhance their own knowledge and spiritual growth. Educating others in The Word was his life's purpose. He will always be remembered for his love of God, dedication and commitment, and his warm and generous spirit.

He is survived by his wife, Corine Taylor; three daughters, Lynn Taylor, Lauren Orada (Romer), and Courtney Vann (Gregg). He was also a proud grandfather

to his granddaughter, Mila Orada. Ronnie is also survived by his mother, Alease Jones, and two siblings, Gordon Taylor (Carolyn) and Teresa Delbridge, along with many nieces and nephews.

A funeral service for Ron will be held at Gethsemane Community Fellowship Baptist Church on Saturday, August 12, at 11 am. 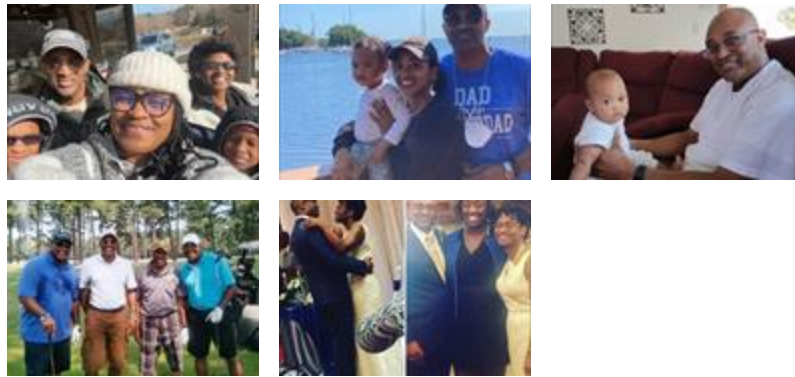
