Rudy Alvin Baker was born in McDonough, Georgia to the late Fannie Mae and Willie Charles Baker on February 15, 1944. He departed this life peacefully to be with his loving wife Doretha on September 16, 2021. Rudy received his education from the Henry County Training School in McDonough, Georgia.

Later in life, Rudy met his best friend Doretha in Baltimore, Maryland, and they were united in holy matrimony for 53 years. Rudy and Doretha loved dining out and traveling. 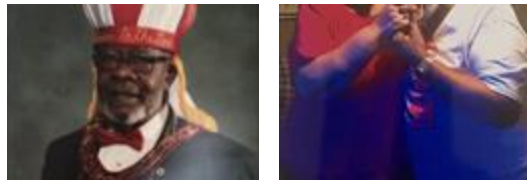
