Square Thomas Williams, Jr., affectionately known as "Bill" was born in Whitesburg, GA on August 15, 1928 to the late Square Thomas Williams, Sr. and Charlie Jean Reid-Williams. He was the oldest of eight, three sons and five daughters. Square departed this earth at his home from natural causes on November 10, 2014. Square was educated in Carroll County, GA. He served faithfully in the United States Navy for twenty three years during World War II and Korea.
