Susan Jean Jarvais (née Lawliss), 71, passed away on September 21, 2025, at Sentara Leigh Hospital, Virginia Beach, Virginia with her daughter by her side. Born on July 22, 1954, in Presque Isle, Maine, Susan lived a life marked by deep faith, unwavering love for her family, and a generous spirit that touched countless lives.

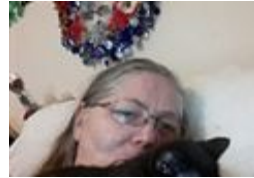
