Sylvia Delores Perry Shaw Boone Smith, 84 was called by God to her heavenly home on November 7, 2020. She was a Mother, Grandmother, Great-Grandmother, neighbor, and friend to many. Born April 11, 1936, she was the only child to the late Booker T. and Verniece Shaw of Portsmouth, VA. They loved her and taught her strong Christian values. At an early age, she was baptized at Ebenezer Baptist Church. Dr. Harvey Johnson was the pastor. She was an active member of many organizations. Sylvia had a special love for her Daddy. She was a great caregiver to both of her parents until their death.

Sylvia attended primary and secondary schools in Portsmouth, VA attending I.C. Norcom High School, Class of 1954. She was a member of the Marching Band and Honor graduate. She attended Norfolk State College, majoring in Home Economics. During Sylvia's childhood, she established a sister bond relationship with Grace Troy-Howey of Richmond, VA.

At a young age Sylvia married James A. Boone, Sr. From that union three children were born; James, Valerie and Eldridge. God sent her a Godly Man, Napoleon Smith, Jr. who assisted her in raising the children. The family attended New Hope Baptist where the Smith family was rooted and grounded in the Lord.

She worked 25 years for Rice's Nachman starting as a Unit Control Clerk on Granby St. in Norfolk, VA and completing her tenure as a Sales Manager at Tower Mall, Portsmouth Va. Later she took a position with Hallmark Cards as a Distributor to local grocery stores traveling throughout the Hampton Roads and Eastern Shores. She worked several years for Sears until she retired, as a Merchandiser.

Sylvia was strong in the Lord and the power of His might. She was a worker who labored in the vineyard. At New Hope Baptist Church, she was member of the Senior Choir, The Busy Bee and The Missionary. She was a member and Past Matron of Venus Chapter #42 Order of Eastern Star-PHA. In Fayetteville, NC under Watch Care Ministry, she attended Simon Temple AME Zion Church where Dr. Brian R. Thompson presides. While in Fayetteville, NC. She was involved with an organization called Seniors on the Move, she

enjoyed craft activity classes, chair exercise and educational seminars. In her classes she knitted hats and crocheted mats for the homeless and cancer awareness. She was happy to get rid of her flip phone and obtained a smart phone so she could stay connected browsing the internet, listening to gospel on YouTube, and taking selfies. Her hobbies were playing the piano, sewing, crocheting hats and blankets, and she also loved to sing songs.

Sylvia's legacy lives through three generations which included three children: James A. Boone, Jr. of Hagerstown, MD, Valerie Annette Scales (James) of Fayetteville, NC, Eldridge A. Boone (Alberta) of Portsmouth, VA; seven grandchildren; Tanika, Michelle, Monique, Ashley, Jonathan, Cris, and Gabriella; seven great-grandchildren Alvin, Ke'Anna, Michael, Jayden, Mikaela, Dylan, Cari and a host of nieces, nephews and other relatives.

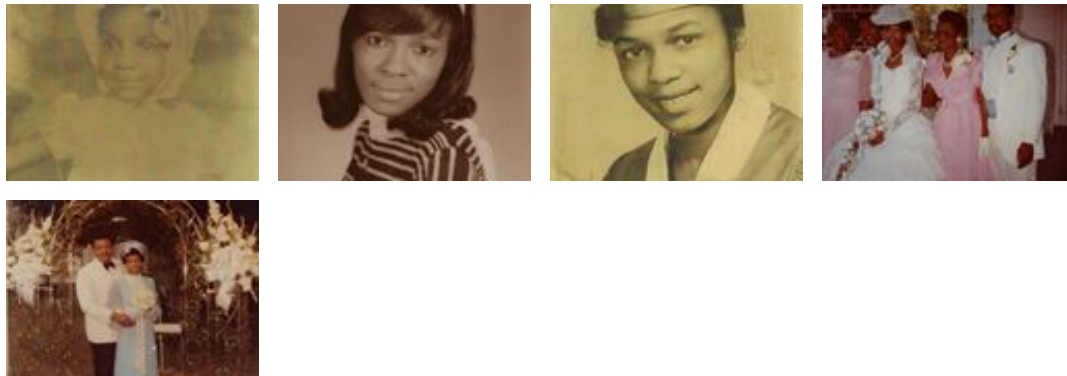
