Rev. Theodore E. Myrick, Jr., 92, of the second block of Pennock Street, was called home to be with the Lord on Saturday, September 14, 2013 at Maryview Medical Center. He retired from Norfolk Naval Shipyard after 30 years of service. Rev. Myrick was Pastor Emeritus of New St. Thomas Baptist Church and was a former Chaplain of Migrant Workers Seasonal Camp in Rich Square, NC.
