Age 66 of the 21000 block of Buckhorn Quarter Road, peacefully, transitioned to eternal rest on Wednesday November 24, 2021, at Obici Hospital in Suffolk, VA. She was born on December 11, 1954, in Portsmouth, Virginia to the late Sidney and Odessa Moore. She attended Portsmouth Public Schools and continued her education at Norfolk State University and Saint Leo College. She retired as a Portsmouth Police Officer in 1999 after 23 years of service, served as an Adult Probation and Parole Officer in Portsmouth and Suffolk, VA District 6 and retired in 2017 as Program Coordinator for the 5th Judicial District Community Corrections Program in Suffolk, VA. She was a member of Community Presbyterian Church and served on the Usher Board, as Chairperson of the Stewardship Committee and an Elder.

She is survived by her husband of 14 years, Colonel (Ret) AUS Linwood "Gerrv" Greene, Jr., a son, Jonathan S. Moore of Orange County, CA; a grand Son, Sidney M. 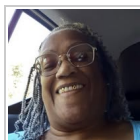
