



Verdell Thomas Nottingham

March 1, 1926 - May 27, 2012

Chesapeake- Verdell Thomas Nottingham, 86, passed peacefully on May 27, 2012 at Maryview Nursing Care Center in Suffolk, VA. Verdell was born to the late Arthur and Mamie Thomas in Norfolk County, VA on March 1, 1926.

Verdell received her high school diploma from Norfolk County Schools and later earned her Bachelor's degree from Norfolk State College, Norfolk, VA as well as a Master's degree from Virginia State College, Petersburg, VA. Verdell's teaching career began at Jacox Junior High and concluded at Azalea Gardens Middle School in Norfolk, VA.

Verdell was a faithful and dedicated member of Grove Baptist Church, Portsmouth, VA where she was a member of the Senior Choir, Sunday School Teacher, former president of the Missionary Committee and representative of Tidewater Baptist Missionary Association. Verdell was also a member of The Links, Inc., Chesapeake Les Gemmes, Inc. and Chesapeake Women's Club. As a retiree, she was elected by Chesapeake City Council as the first African American female to serve on the Chesapeake General Hospital Authority where she served for over 10 years.

Verdell is survived by her daughter, Mary Eley (William) of Portsmouth, VA; granddaughters, Shelly Redd (David) of Chesapeake, VA and Tiffany Roseborough of Los Angeles, CA; great granddaughter, Danielle Bouldin of

Chesapeake, VA and a host of other loving relatives and friends.
