Vincent "Chief" Rudolph Bates, 93, of Portsmouth, VA died February 20, 2019. Vincent attended Portsmouth Public Schools and graduated from I. C. Norcom High School in 1944. Vincent served in the United States Navy proudly for 30 years during WWII, the Korean Conflict, and the Vietnam War. He received numerous honors and awards, and retired at the rank of Chief Boatswain Mate. He continued to serve our country as a Shop 72 Rigger at the Norfolk Naval Shipyard for 10 years.

Vincent was preceded by his wife, Rosa Bates; son, William "Eddie" Bates; siblings, Phillip Bates, Riley Bates, Jr., Ruby Williams, and Quintella Sommerville.
