March 17, 1925 - June 21, 2016

We lost a sweet, loving and gentle man on Tuesday, June 21, 2016 with the passing of Walter Peyton Reynolds (Sonny). He was born in Portsmouth, Virginia on March 17, 1925, living a long life passing at 91 years of age.

On April 10, 1947, he married the “love of his life” Helen Smith. They were married for 69 years serving together faithfully as Jehovah’s Witnesses. He was baptized as one of Jehovah’s Witnesses on July 14, 1962 and served as an elder in several congregations for more than 20 years. He loved art, cartoons, music – almost any kind from country to jazz, classical, opera, and the color red.

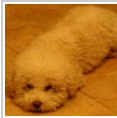
