Portsmouth – William E. Jones, Jr. peacefully entered into eternal rest on Wednesday, August 16, 2012 at home surrounded by his family.

He was born March 13, 1928 to the late William E. Jones, Sr. and Mable Virginia Gee. He was educated at the Sussex County Training School and later continued his studies at Tidewater Community College. At the age of 17, he joined the United States Navy and served his country faithfully for 30 years. After retirement, he was employed by the Norfolk Naval Shipyard, Portsmouth as a police officer where he remained until retirement.

He was a faithful and active member of New Bethel Baptist Church, Portsmouth, Virginia. While serving in ministry there, he sang in the choir and served on the Men's Usher Board for several years.
