



William Norfleet Taylor, Jr.

April 19, 1933 - November 17, 2023

William Norfleet Taylor Jr., (affectionately known as Bill) was born on April 19, 1933, to the late William Norfleet Taylor Sr., and Grace Atkins in Portsmouth, VA. He spent his childhood in Portsmouth and attended I.C. Norcom High School. During the height of his high school years, he embarked upon his career at Norfolk Naval Shipyard. From there he started with Military Sealift Command (MSC) as a Merchant Seaman. Bill served in MSC for 35 years, starting as Wiper, and elevated himself to Chief Electrician on the ships.

In 1976, Bill met Lucy in New York. They relocated to Virginia Beach in 1987 and were married in 1988. In 1991, Bill retired after 35 years with Military Sealift Command (MSC). He became an entrepreneur owning several businesses with his wife Lucy. Together they owned: an apartment building and The Fairtree Lounge and Bar in the Bronx, NY as well as a taxi business in Portsmouth, VA. All under the name of "Billou", a combination of their names Bill and Lucy.

Bill loved spending time with family, watching football, and television shows. He was an avid storyteller and occasionally these stories were filled with yeast! He was also an adventurous man who enjoyed riding his motorcycle. Bill and Lucy frequently traveled to visit family and friends. There were trips for weddings,

birthdays, new additions to the family holiday parties, graduations, christenings, and many more. We have to mention that one of Bill's favorite pastimes involved drinking his signature wine, Taylor Tawny Port, in a water glass, filled with ice cubes.

The visits and calls Bill received in the last months of his life were a tremendous source of joy, peace, and comfort to him.

Bill is predeceased by his mother and father, one sibling, three children, and two grandchildren.

He is survived by: his wife Lucy, sister Jackie, six children, three daughters-in-law, 24 grandchildren, 34 great-grandchildren, and 7 great-great grandchildren, as well as a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, friends, and loved ones.

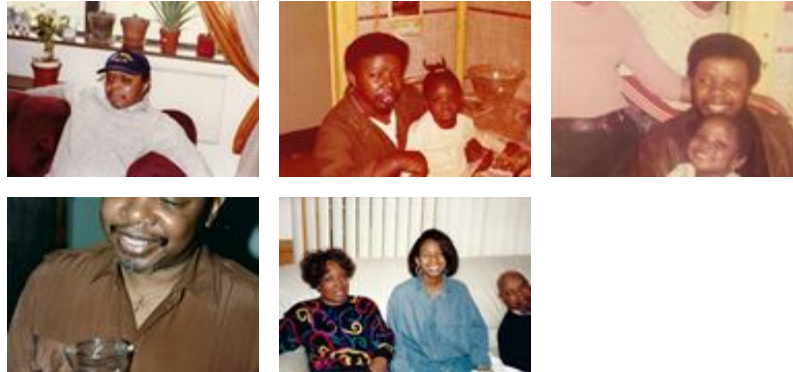
